We do our best to support those with greatest needs and least resources. We have a national and international network of doctors with whom we consult for a wide variety of medical problems. Their support is greatly appreciated.

Dr. Leila volunteers at the provincial hospital every week, where challenging pediatric patients are referred. She volunteers at the district hospital with the first Akha doctor in Laos and in Thailand whom we helped gain acceptance into medical school six years ago. Public health and prevention are emphasized with every patient encounter.

In addition she continues to support the pediatric graduates and their continuing medical education.

# Ban Nongboua Primary School ໂຮງຮຽນ ບ້ານ ໝອງບົວ

We helped with \$55,000 USD to build a school building for a government primary school to replace a building that the parents constructed from sticks with a thatch roof and dirt floor.

The new school has five classrooms, one kindergarten toilet, two storage rooms, and an outdoor learning center with a stage. The design has been influenced by schools we visited in the Lao PDR, Thailand and Mongolia. The school building is wheelchair accessible with a ramp, and large doors.

We provide ongoing support to the school by providing teaching assistants and supplies.

The Butterfly Children's Development Center enhances the physical and mental development of children in Muang Sing with a focus towards school health.

The Butterfly Children's Development Center is located in a classroom of the Lao Government Primary School in Ban Nong Boua, Muang Sing District, Luang Namtha Province.

Children's Development Center Activities are scheduled when school is over for the day and on Saturdays. The center also operates during school holidays.



## Scholarships ທຶນການ ສຶກສາ

We look for deserving students whom we believe will support and benefit their community and their country. The scholarship page on the website lists these scholarships.

Several university students are studying to become teachers. They are being supported with scholarships focused towards ethnic minorities and women.

Five deaf students are now studying at the Government Deaf Schools in Luang Prabang and Vientiane. A blind boy who is attending the Government Blind School in Vientiane for his second year with our support.

One foster student who comes from a problem family also receive scholarship support.

The Butterfly Children's Development Center offers scholarships for young leaders and exceptional teachers to study at the Donkhai Children's Development Center in Vientiane.
